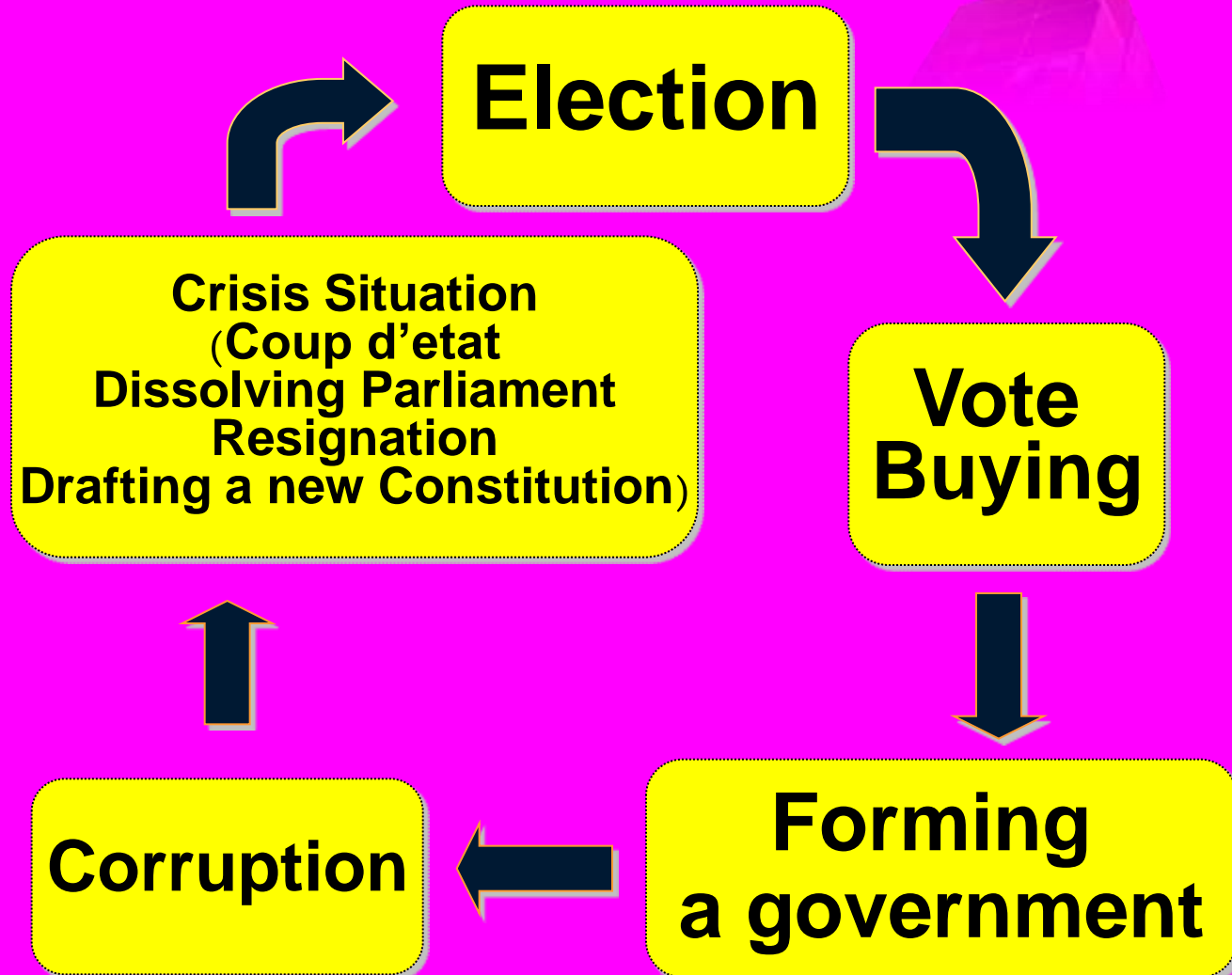


84 years of Thailand's Democracy

but the opponent aren't.**

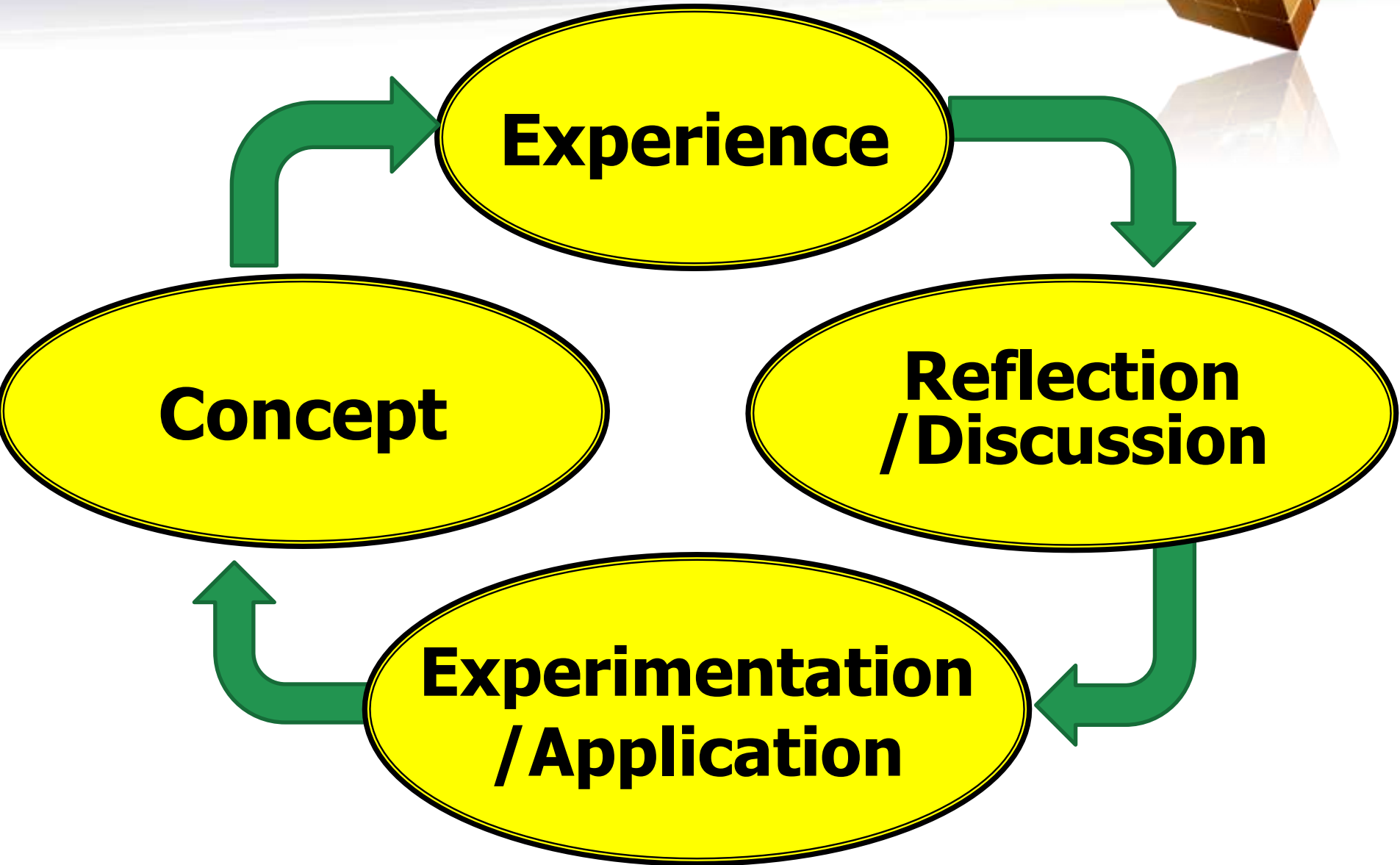

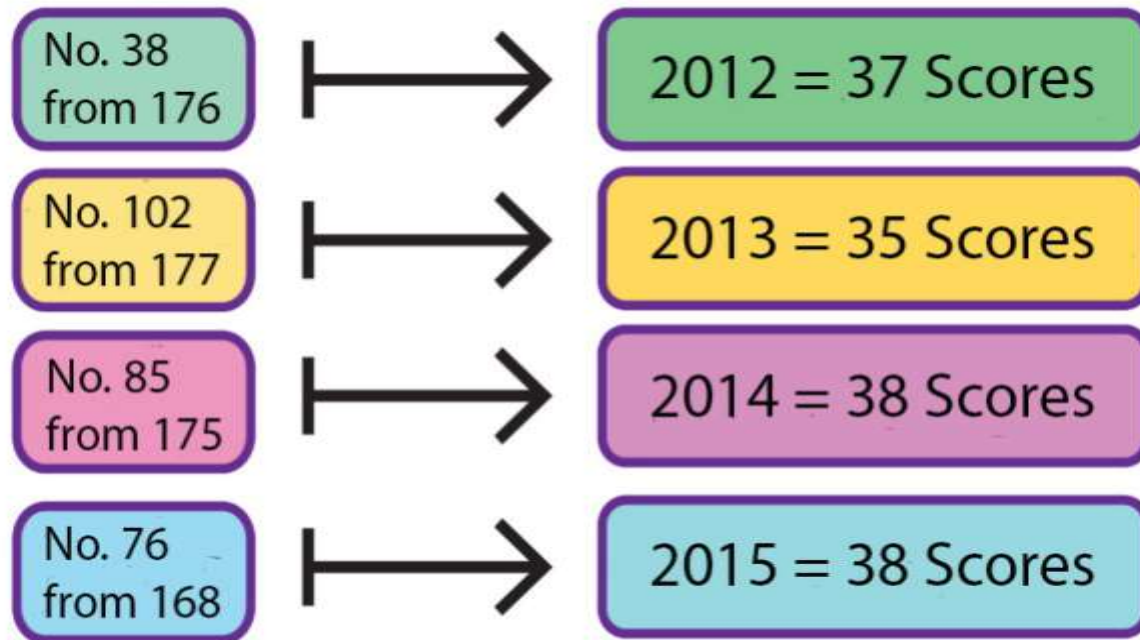

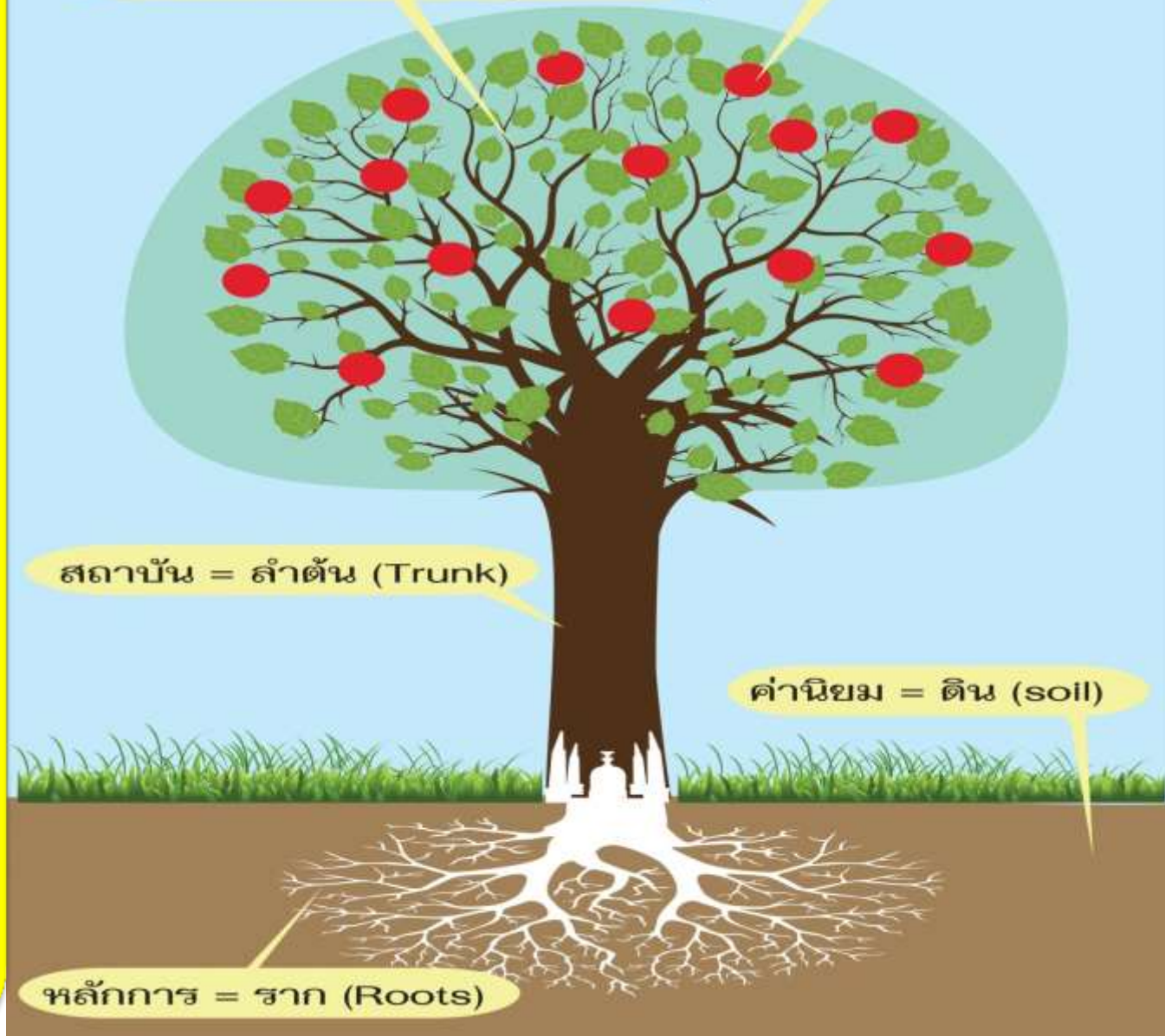
ประโยชน์ = ดอกผล (Fruits)

To promote democratic activities.

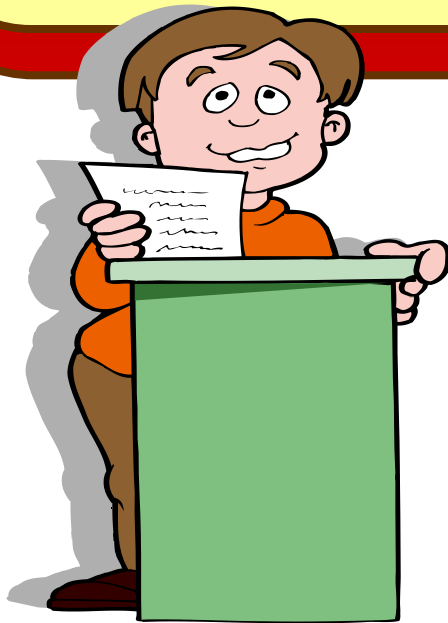
To equip strong and quality people.
